




 - Sanctuary wide regulations
 - Additional marine zone regulations
 - Marine zones
 - Management Plan



Priority: Management Effectiveness & Adaptive Management

- Understanding the effectiveness of these strategies is necessary
- ONMS will work with partners to conduct monitoring to evaluate management measures, and then shift or revise management approaches to address areas or issues where current resource protection efforts are not meeting the desired goals

<u>Activity 1.1.5</u>: Establish a Sanctuary Advisory Council Research Advisory Working Group to provide recommendations on priority research needs and application of available science to conservation-based management, including adaptive management needs and opportunities.






